Agenda Items -

1. Golf Course Financial Update –

• Denise presented Revenue Charts and Expense Charts for current year. Revenue was down slightly in August but the total revenue for July and August was approximately \$10,000 higher than FY 22. Revenue verses Expenses reflects \$206,000 to the good. Off to a good start for FY 23.

• Golf Course Improvements Progress-

• Rich Reported -

- 1. Hole # 5 on Executive has been sprigged with Iron Cutter Bermuda and is about 75% done. Some sandy areas may have to be sodded.
- 2. The FY 23 budget has \$35,000 appropriated for paving of Cart Paths. Since the budgeted amount will not do all cart paths a decision has to be made on which sections will be paved.

3. Golfers Comments -

- GPS has been "synchronized" with flags. Greatly improved.
- Issues with Sand Traps was discussed.
- Rough is pretty "rough" for those who have errant shots.
- Kudos to the maintenance staff on their fast and efficient aerification of the greens.

4. Cafe Feedback – Rich

- Cafe has added a new "Breakfast Sausage" to menu. It's a 4 oz link with sage.
- Cafe running very smoothly.

5. Pavilion Project Update -

- One garage door remains to be installed. That installation is scheduled for next week.
- HVAC work will begin once pavilion is enclosed.
- Gutters are going up.
- Rentals for the pavilion will begin slowly to work out kinks.
- Rich is investigating the possibility of hosting "Concerts" at the new pavilion in 2023.
